




Any business/organization can become recognized as dementia friendly. From grocery stores to restaurants and real estate agencies to churches, there is a specific training tailored for each type of business. All sectors of the community need to be equipped and ready to serve clients with dementia.

Perks for Dementia Friendly Business/ Organization

- Receive a "Dementia Friendly Business" window decal for store front and certificate
- Logo placed on Dementia Friendly Iowa website & shoutout on the social media pages
- Gain skills to identify and communicate with a customer/client who may have dementia
- Individual staff members will be considered "Dementia Friends"

What does my organization/business do to be recognized as a Dementia Friendly business?

- Attend/host a one-hour training presented by a dementia friendly trainer. Scan the QR code to register.
- A minimum of 50% of staff/volunteers with a goal of 100% must attend training.
- Agree to discuss and consider dementia friendly changes in your business/organization
- Agree to support people living with dementia and caregivers as much as possible
- This training is offered on a free will donation.





A dementia friendly business/organization:

- Receives education for management and staff about dementia to serve customers better.
- Recognizes signs of dementia in customers or clients.
- Communicates more effectively with patience and understanding.
- Works to develop and maintain business practices that keep people with dementia in mind.

You can still host a Dementia Friends session for your group or organization for all attendees to gain a basic understanding of dementia and become Dementia Friends.
